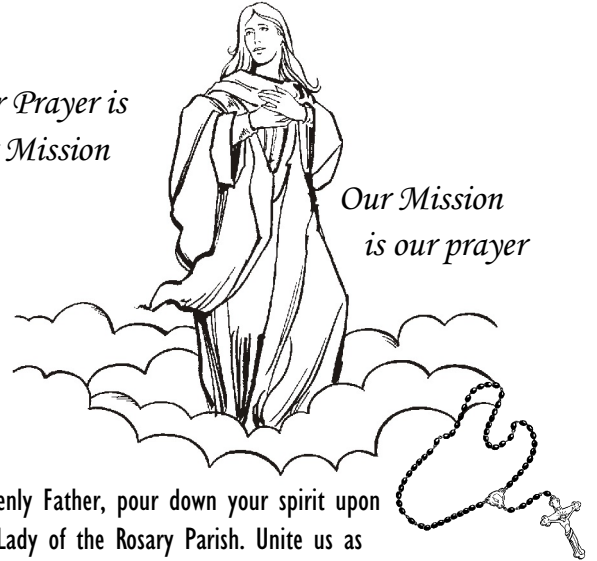
- ✠ Morning Prayer: 6:45 before morning Mass.
