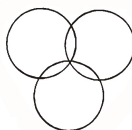

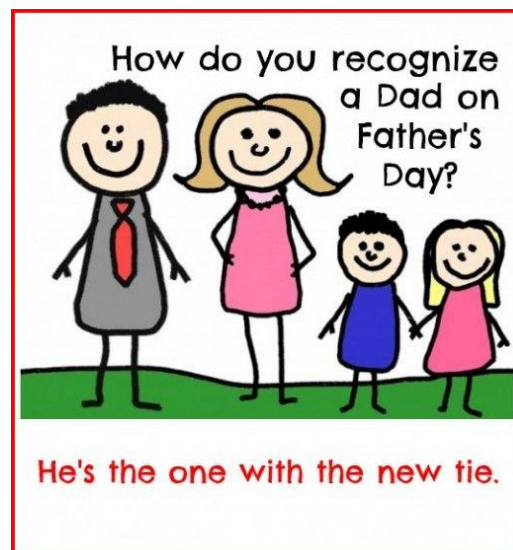

A new survey of nearly 37,000 men and women show that people who regularly attend church, synagogue or other religious services are less likely to suffer from depression and other psychiatric illnesses than those who don't. The report states that the higher the worship frequency, the lower the odds of depression, mania, and panic disorders. The study was presented at the annual meeting of the American Psychiatric Association. The findings add to growing evidence that faith positively affects your mental well-being. Spirituality is dramatically important against both physical and mental illness.
