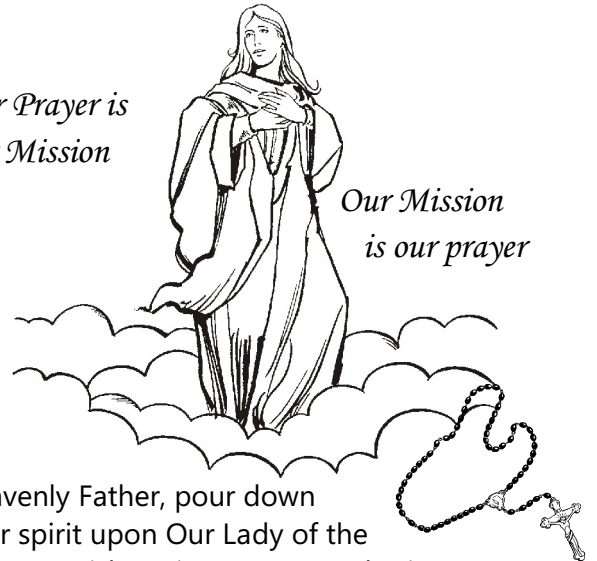

## CELEBRATION

The Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is today. Our parish celebration begins today, Sunday, October 7<sup>th</sup> at the 10:45 a.m. Mass where we open our Annual Parish Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament (the *Forty Hours Devotion*). After the 10:45 a.m. Mass, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar in the Monstrance and will be present to us all day until evening devotions at 6:00 p.m. During the afternoon, you are invited to share the blessing of our parish *Rosary Rally* at 3:00 p.m., honoring Mary, Queen of the Rosary.

The blessing continues tomorrow, Monday, October 8<sup>th</sup> as we open the day with Mass at 7:00 a.m., followed with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament all throughout the day with Benediction and evening prayer at 6:00 p.m.

More blessings are offered us, as on Tuesday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, we begin with Mass at 7:00 a.m. followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament throughout the day, ending with evening prayer starting at 6:00 p.m. from the Divine Liturgy of the Hours, Special Procession, Communion Service and Solemn Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.
