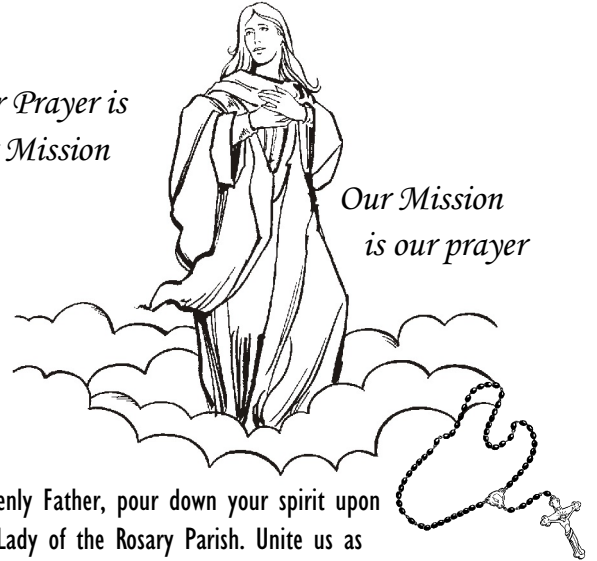

You can also mail in your requests. These forms can be found in the back of church today. Church law forbids us to accept more Mass intentions than we can fulfill in one year. Once this book is filled up, we cannot accept additional Masses for the year 2020. There is no limit, at this time, on Sunday Masses however, we expect everyone to be considerate of other people. Excessive requests from the same person may not be honored. Also, in fairness to everyone in the parish, we cannot accept any intentions until 8:00 a.m. on October 16<sup>th</sup>. Mailed-in requests will be honored on a first-come first-served basis. Your cooperation in this matter will be deeply appreciated. Archdiocesan policy dictates a \$10 offering for announced Masses. As always, if a person cannot afford a Mass offering and notifies us of that fact, we will honor his/her request.
